

# FEAR NOT

The following is a listing of the commandments in Scripture to ‘fear not’. Not all fear is sinful, but clearly, some fear is rebellion against these commands to ‘fear not’. If fear and worry are a part of your life, take some time and read and meditate on these passages. Embrace the command to “Fear Not” as something God expects you to obey. Look up the context of each of these passages in your version of the Bible. Consider the audience to whom each passage is written. Ask yourself if God expected them to obey. Ask yourself if God would expect the same from you. Is God’s power to overcome big enough to help you in your life and circumstances? As you look at the context, identify the reasons that God commands you to “fear not”. Do you see the results (hope, help, promises, blessings, etc.) of refusing to be controlled by fear? Commit your concerns to prayer and ask God to give you the strength to seek to please Him, regardless of your circumstances.

*Faithful is he that calleth you, who also will do it . (1 Thess. 5:24)*

Genesis 15:1 After these things the word of the LORD came unto Abram in a vision, saying, **FEAR NOT**, Abram: I am thy shield, and thy exceeding great reward.

Genesis 21:17 And God heard the voice of the lad; and the angel of God called Hagar out of heaven, and said unto her, What aileth thee, Hagar? **FEAR NOT**; for God hath heard the voice of the lad where he is.

Genesis 26:24 And the LORD appeared unto him the same night, and said, I am the God of Abraham thy father: **FEAR NOT**, for I am with thee, and will bless thee, and multiply thy seed for my servant Abraham's sake.

Genesis 35:17 And it came to pass, when she was in hard labour, that the midwife said unto her, **FEAR NOT**; thou shalt have this son also.

Genesis 43:23 And he said, Peace be to you, **FEAR NOT**: your God, and the God of your father, hath given you treasure in your sacks: I had your money. And he brought Simeon out unto them.

Genesis 46:3 And he said, I am God, the God of thy father: **FEAR NOT** to go down into Egypt; for I will there make of thee a great nation:

Genesis 50:19 And Joseph said unto them, **FEAR NOT**: for am I in the place of God?

Exodus 20:20 And Moses said unto the people, **FEAR NOT**: for God is come to prove you, and that his fear may be before your faces, that ye sin not.

Leviticus 26:6 And I will give peace in the land, and ye shall lie down, and **none shall make you afraid**: and I will rid evil beasts out of the land, neither shall the sword go through your land.

Deuteronomy 1:21 Behold, the LORD thy God hath set the land before thee: go up and possess it, as the LORD God of thy fathers hath said unto thee; **FEAR NOT**, neither be discouraged.

Deuteronomy 20:3 And shall say unto them, Hear, O Israel, ye approach this day unto battle against your enemies: let not your hearts faint, **FEAR NOT**, and do not tremble, neither be ye terrified because of them;

Deuteronomy 31:6 Be strong and of a good courage, **FEAR NOT**, nor be afraid of them: for the LORD thy God, he it is that doth go with thee; he will not fail thee, nor forsake thee.

Deuteronomy 31:8 And the LORD, he it is that doth go before thee; he will be with thee, he will not fail thee, neither forsake thee: **FEAR NOT**, neither be dismayed.

Joshua 8:1 And the LORD said unto Joshua, **FEAR NOT**, neither be thou dismayed: take all the people of war with thee, and arise, go up to Ai: see, I have given into thy hand the king of Ai, and his people, and his city, and his land:

Joshua 10:25 And Joshua said unto them, **FEAR NOT**, nor be dismayed, be strong and of good courage: for thus shall the LORD do to all your enemies against whom ye fight.

Judges 4:18 And Jael went out to meet Sisera, and said unto him, Turn in, my lord, turn in to me; **FEAR NOT**. And when he had turned in unto her into the tent, she covered him with a mantle.

Judges 6:10 And I said unto you, I am the LORD your God; **FEAR NOT** the gods of the Amorites, in whose land ye dwell: but ye have not obeyed my voice.

Judges 6:23 And the LORD said unto him, Peace be unto thee; **FEAR NOT**: thou shalt not die.

Ruth 3:11 And now, my daughter, **FEAR NOT**; I will do to thee all that thou requirest: for all the city of my people doth know that thou art a virtuous woman.

1 Samuel 4:20 And about the time of her death the women that stood by her said unto her, **FEAR NOT**; for thou hast born a son. But she answered not, neither did she regard it.

1 Samuel 12:20 And Samuel said unto the people, **FEAR NOT**: ye have done all this wickedness: yet turn not aside from following the LORD, but serve the LORD with all your heart;

1 Samuel 22:23 Abide thou with me, **FEAR NOT**: for he that seeketh my life seeketh thy life: but with me thou shalt be in safeguard.

1 Samuel 23:17 And he said unto him, **FEAR NOT**: for the hand of Saul my father shall not find thee; and thou shalt be king over Israel, and I shall be next unto thee; and that also Saul my father knoweth.

2 Samuel 9:7 And David said unto him, **FEAR NOT**: for I will surely shew thee kindness for Jonathan thy father's sake, and will restore thee all the land of Saul thy father; and thou shalt eat bread at my table continually.

2 Samuel 13:28 Now Absalom had commanded his servants, saying, Mark ye now when Amnon's heart is merry with wine, and when I say unto you, Smite Amnon; then kill him, **FEAR NOT**: have not I commanded you? be courageous and be valiant.

1 Kings 17:13 And Elijah said unto her, **FEAR NOT**; go and do as thou hast said: but make me thereof a little cake first, and bring it unto me, and after make for thee and for thy son.

2 Kings 6:16 And he answered, **FEAR NOT**: for they that be with us are more than they that be with them.

2 Kings 17:34 Unto this day they do after the former manners: they **FEAR NOT** the LORD, neither do they after their statutes, or after their ordinances, or after the law and commandment which the LORD commanded the children of Jacob, whom he named Israel;

2 Kings 25:24 And Gedaliah sware to them, and to their men, and said unto them, **FEAR NOT** to be the servants of the Chaldees: dwell in the land, and serve the king of Babylon; and it shall be well with you.

1 Chronicles 28:20 And David said to Solomon his son, Be strong and of good courage, and do it: **FEAR NOT**, nor be dismayed: for the LORD God, even my God, will be with thee; he will not fail thee, nor forsake thee, until thou hast finished all the work for the service of the house of the LORD.

2 Chronicles 20:17 Ye shall not need to fight in this battle: set yourselves, stand ye still, and see the salvation of the LORD with you, O Judah and Jerusalem: **FEAR NOT**, nor be dismayed; to morrow go out against them: for the LORD will be with you.

Psalms 55:19 God shall hear, and afflict them, even he that abideth of old. Selah. Because they have no changes, therefore they **FEAR NOT** God.

Psalms 64:4 That they may shoot in secret at the perfect: suddenly do they shoot at him, and **FEAR NOT**.

Isaiah 7:4 And say unto him, Take heed, and be quiet; **FEAR NOT**, neither be fainthearted for the two tails of these smoking firebrands, for the fierce anger of Rezin with Syria, and of the son of Remaliah.

Isaiah 35:4 Say to them that are of a fearful heart, Be strong, **FEAR NOT**: behold, your God will come with vengeance, even God with a recompence; he will come and save you.

Isaiah 41:10 **FEAR THOU NOT**; for I am with thee: be not dismayed; for I am thy God: I will strengthen thee; yea, I will help thee; yea, I will uphold thee with the right hand of my righteousness.

Isaiah 41:13 For I the LORD thy God will hold thy right hand, saying unto thee, **FEAR NOT**; I will help thee.

Isaiah 41:14 **FEAR NOT**, thou worm Jacob, and ye men of Israel; I will help thee, saith the LORD, and thy redeemer, the Holy One of Israel.

Isaiah 43:1 But now thus saith the LORD that created thee, O Jacob, and he that formed thee, O Israel, **FEAR NOT**: for I have redeemed thee, I have called thee by thy name; thou art mine.

Isaiah 43:5 **FEAR NOT**: for I am with thee: I will bring thy seed from the east, and gather thee from the west;

Isaiah 44:2 Thus saith the LORD that made thee, and formed thee from the womb, which will help thee; **FEAR NOT**, O Jacob, my servant; and thou, Jesurun, whom I have chosen.

Isaiah 54:4 **FEAR NOT**; for thou shalt not be ashamed: neither be thou confounded; for thou shalt not be put to shame: for thou shalt forget the shame of thy youth, and shalt not remember the reproach of thy widowhood any more.

Jeremiah 23:4 And I will set up shepherds over them which shall feed them: and **they shall fear no more**, nor be dismayed, neither shall they be lacking, saith the LORD.

Jeremiah 30:10 Therefore **FEAR THOU NOT**, O my servant Jacob, saith the LORD; neither be dismayed, O Israel: for, lo, I will save thee from afar, and thy seed from the land of their captivity; and Jacob shall return, and shall be in rest, and be quiet, and **none shall make him afraid**.

Jeremiah 40:9 And Gedaliah the son of Ahikam the son of Shaphan sware unto them and to their men, saying, **FEAR NOT** to serve the Chaldeans: dwell in the land, and serve the king of Babylon, and it shall be well with you.

Jeremiah 46:27 But **FEAR NOT** thou, O my servant Jacob, and be not dismayed, O Israel: for, behold, I will save thee from afar off, and thy seed from the land of their captivity; and Jacob shall return, and be in rest and at ease, and none shall make him afraid.

Jeremiah 46:28 **FEAR THOU NOT**, O Jacob my servant, saith the LORD: for I am with thee; for I will make a full end of all the nations whither I have driven thee: but I will not make a full end of thee, but correct thee in measure; yet will I not leave thee wholly unpunished.

Lamentations 3:57 Thou drewest near in the day that I called upon thee: thou saidst, **FEAR NOT**.

Daniel 10:12 Then said he unto me, **FEAR NOT**, Daniel: for from the first day that thou didst set thine heart to understand, and to chasten thyself before thy God, thy words were heard, and I am come for thy words.

Daniel 10:19 And said, O man greatly beloved, **FEAR NOT**: peace be unto thee, be strong, yea, be strong. And when he had spoken unto me, I was strengthened, and said, Let my lord speak; for thou hast strengthened me.

Joel 2:21 **FEAR NOT**, O land; be glad and rejoice: for the LORD will do great things.

Zephaniah 3:16 In that day it shall be said to Jerusalem, **FEAR THOU NOT**: and to Zion, Let not thine hands be slack.

Zechariah 8:13 And it shall come to pass, that as ye were a curse among the heathen, O house of Judah, and house of Israel; so will I save you, and ye shall be a blessing: **FEAR NOT**, but let your hands be strong.

Malachi 3:5 And I will come near to you to judgment; and I will be a swift witness against the sorcerers, and against the adulterers, and against false swearers, and against those that oppress the hireling in his wages, the widow, and the fatherless, and that turn aside the stranger from his right, and **FEAR NOT** me, saith the LORD of hosts.

Matthew 1:20 But while he thought on these things, behold, the angel of the Lord appeared unto him in a dream, saying, Joseph, thou son of David, **FEAR NOT** to take unto thee Mary thy wife: for that which is conceived in her is of the Holy Ghost.

Matthew 10:28 And **FEAR NOT** them which kill the body, but are not able to kill the soul: but rather fear him which is able to destroy both soul and body in hell.

Matthew 28:5 And the angel answered and said unto the women, **FEAR NOT** ye: for I know that ye seek Jesus, which was crucified.

Luke 1:13 But the angel said unto him, **FEAR NOT**, Zacharias: for thy prayer is heard; and thy wife Elisabeth shall bear thee a son, and thou shalt call his name John.

Luke 1:30 And the angel said unto her, **FEAR NOT**, Mary: for thou hast found favour with God.

Luke 2:10 And the angel said unto them, **FEAR NOT**: for, behold, I bring you good tidings of great joy, which shall be to all people.

Luke 5:10 And so was also James, and John, the sons of Zebedee, which were partners with Simon. And Jesus said unto Simon, **FEAR NOT**: from henceforth thou shalt catch men.

Luke 8:50 But when Jesus heard it, he answered him, saying, **FEAR NOT**: believe only, and she shall be made whole.

Luke 12:7 But even the very hairs of your head are all numbered. **FEAR NOT** therefore: ye are of more value than many sparrows.

Luke 12:32 **FEAR NOT**, little flock; for it is your Father's good pleasure to give you the kingdom.

Luke 18:4 And he would not for a while: but afterward he said within himself, Though I **FEAR NOT** God, nor regard man;

John 12:15 **FEAR NOT**, daughter of Sion: behold, thy King cometh, sitting on an ass's colt.

Acts 27:24 Saying, **FEAR NOT**, Paul; thou must be brought before Caesar: and, lo, God hath given thee all them that sail with thee.

1 Peter 2:18 Servants, be subject to your masters with all fear; not only to the good and gentle, but also to the froward.

Revelation 1:17 And when I saw him, I fell at his feet as dead. And he laid his right hand upon me, saying unto me, **FEAR NOT**; I am the first and the last:
