• <sup>13</sup>Let no one say when he is tempted, "I am being tempted by God," for God cannot be tempted with evil, and he himself tempts no one. <sup>14</sup>But each person is tempted, when he is lured and enticed by his own desire. 15Then desire, when it is conceived, give birth to sin: and sin, when it is fully grown brings forth death. <sup>16</sup>Do not be deceived, my beloved brothers. 
#### Change begins with a New Heart



### Repentance Involves Grief

Titus] told us of your longing, your mourning, your zeal for me, so that I rejoiced still more. 8For even if I made you grieve with my letter, I do not regret it—though I did regret it, for I see that that letter grieved you, though only for a while. <sup>9</sup>As it is, I rejoice, not because you were grieved, but because you were grieved into repenting. For you felt a godly grief, so that you suffered no loss through us. 10 For godly grief produces a repentance that leads to salvation without regret, whereas worldly grief produces death. 11 For see what earnestness this godly grief has produced in you, (2 Cor. 7:7-11)


