

ONE-ANOTHERING

The Bible is full of commands regarding "one-anothering." The following is a partial list of examples to read and consider.

1. Leviticus 19:16 You shall not go around as a slanderer among your people, and you shall not stand up against the life of your neighbor: I am the LORD.¹⁷ "You shall not hate your brother in your heart, but you shall reason frankly with your neighbor, lest you incur sin because of him."¹⁸ You shall not take vengeance or bear a grudge against the sons of your own people, but you shall love your neighbor as yourself: I am the LORD.
2. Prov 14:21 Whoever **despises** his neighbor is a sinner, but blessed is he who is generous to the poor.
3. Matt 22:39 And a second is like it: You shall love your neighbor as yourself.
4. Mark 6:34 When he went ashore he saw a great crowd, and he had compassion on them, because they were like sheep without a shepherd. And he began to teach them many things.
5. Mark 9:50 Salt is good, but if the salt has lost its saltiness, how will you make it salty again? Have salt in yourselves, and **be at peace** with one another.
6. John 13:34 A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another: just as I have loved you, you also are to **love** one another.
7. John 15:12 This is my commandment, that you **love** one another as I have loved you. (see John 15:1-17)
8. Romans 12:10a **Love** one another with brotherly affection.
9. Romans 12:10b **Outdo** one another in showing honor.(See Romans 12:10-16)
10. Romans 13:8 Owe no one anything, except to **love** each other, for the one who **loves** another has fulfilled the law.
11. Romans 14:13 Therefore **let us not pass judgment** on one another any longer, but rather decide never to put a stumbling block or hindrance in the way of a brother.
12. Rom 14:15 For if your brother is grieved by what you eat, you are no longer walking in love. By what you eat, **do not destroy** the one for whom Christ died.
13. Romans 14:19 So then let us pursue what makes for **peace** and for mutual upbuilding.
14. Rom 14:21 It is good not to eat meat or drink wine or do anything that causes your brother to stumble.
15. Romans 15:2 Let each of us please his neighbor for his good, to build him up.
16. Romans 15:5 May the God of endurance and encouragement grant you to **live in such harmony** with one another, in accord with Christ Jesus,
17. Romans 15:7 Therefore **welcome** one another as Christ has welcomed you, for the glory of God.
18. Romans 15:14 I myself am satisfied about you, my brothers, that you yourselves are full of goodness, filled with all knowledge and able to **instruct** one another.
19. Romans 16:16 **Greet** one another with a holy kiss. All the churches of Christ greet you.
20. 1 Cor 1:10 I appeal to you, brothers, by the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that all of you agree, and that there be no divisions among you, but that you be united in the **same mind** and the **same judgment**.
21. 1 Cor 9:19-20 For though I am free from all, I have made myself a servant to all, that I might win more of them.²⁰ To the Jews I became as a Jew, in order to win Jews. To those under the law I became as one under the law (though not being myself under the law) that I might win those under the law.
22. 1 Cor 10:24 Let no one seek his own good, but the good of his neighbor.
23. 1 Cor 10:33 just as I try to please everyone in everything I do, not seeking my own advantage, but that of many, that they may be saved.
24. 1 Cor 13:5 or rude. It does not insist on its own way; it is not irritable or resentful;
25. 1 Cor 16:20 All the brothers send you greetings. **Greet** one another with a holy kiss.
26. 2 Cor 4:5 For what we proclaim is not ourselves, but Jesus Christ as Lord, with ourselves as **your servants for Jesus' sake**.
27. 2 Cor 13:12 **Greet** one another with a holy kiss.
28. Gal 5:13 For you were called to freedom, brothers. Only do not use your freedom as an opportunity for the flesh, but through love serve one another.
29. Galatians 6:2 **Bear** one another's burdens, and so fulfill the law of Christ.

30. Eph 4:2 with all humility and gentleness, with patience, **bearing** with one another in love,
31. Eph 4:12 to equip the saints for the work of ministry, for **building up** the body of Christ,
32. Ephesians 4:29 Let no corrupting talk come out of your mouths, but only such as is good for **building up**, as fits the occasion, that it may **give grace** to those who hear.
33. Eph 4:32a Be **kind** to one another
34. Eph 4:32b **tenderhearted** [to one another]
35. Eph 4:32c **forgiving** one another, as God in Christ forgave you.
36. Eph 5:19 **addressing** one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody to the Lord with your heart
37. Ephesians 5:21 **submitting** to one another out of reverence for Christ.
38. Phil 2:4 Let each of you look not only to his own interests, but also to the interests of others.
39. Colossians 3:9 **Do not lie** to one another, seeing that you have put off the old self with its practices
40. Col 3:13a **bearing** with one another
41. Col 3:13b and, **forgiving** each other; **as the Lord** has forgiven you, **so you also** must forgive.
42. Col 3:16 Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly, **teaching and admonishing** one another in all wisdom, singing psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, with thankfulness in your hearts to God.
43. 1 Thess 4:9 Now concerning brotherly **love** you have no need for anyone to write to you, for you yourselves have been taught by God to love one another,
44. 1 Thess 4:18 Therefore **encourage** one another with these words.
45. 1 Thess 5:11a Therefore **encourage** one another
46. 1 Thess 5:11b and **build** one another up, just as you are doing.
47. Heb 3:13 But **exhort** one another every day, as long as it is called "today," that none of you may be hardened by the deceitfulness of sin.
48. Heb 10:24 And let us **consider** one another to provoke unto love and to good works:
49. Heb 10:25 not neglecting to meet together, as is the habit of some, but **encouraging** one another, and all the more as you see the Day drawing near.
50. James 5:16 Therefore, **confess your sins** to one another and pray for one another, that you may be healed. The prayer of a righteous person has great power as it is working.
51. 1 Peter 1:22 Having purified your souls by your obedience to the truth for a sincere brotherly love, **love** one another earnestly from a pure heart,
52. 1 Peter 3:8 Finally, all of you, have **unity of mind, sympathy, brotherly love, a tender heart, and a humble mind**.
53. 1 Peter 4:8 Above all, keep **loving** one another earnestly, since love covers a multitude of sins.
54. 1 Peter 5:5 Likewise, you who are younger, be subject to the elders. Clothe yourselves, all of you, **with humility** toward one another, for "God opposes the proud but gives grace to the humble."
55. 1 Peter 5:14 **Greet** one another with the kiss of love. Peace to all of you who are in Christ.
56. 1 John 3:11 For this is the message that you have heard from the beginning, that we should **love** one another.
57. 1 John 3:23 And this is his commandment, that we believe in the name of his Son Jesus Christ and **love** one another, just as he has commanded us.
58. 1 John 4:7 Beloved, let us **love** one another, for love is from God, and whoever loves has been born of God and knows God.
59. 1 John 4:11 Beloved, if God so loved us, we also ought to **love** one another.
60. 1 John 4:12 No one has ever seen God; if we **love** one another, God abides in us and his love is perfected in us.
61. 1 John 1:7 But if we **walk in the light**, as he is in the light, **we have fellowship** with one another, and the blood of Jesus his Son cleanses us from all sin.
62. 1 John 3:23 And this is his commandment, that we believe in the name of his Son Jesus Christ and **love** one another, just as he has commanded us.
63. 1 John 4:11 Beloved, if God so loved us, we also ought to **love** one another.
64. 2 John 5 And now I ask you, dear lady— not as though I were writing you a new commandment, but the one we have had from the beginning— that we **love** one another.
65. Jude 20-21 But you, beloved, building yourselves up in your most holy faith and praying in the Holy Spirit, keep yourselves in the **love** of God, waiting for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ that leads to eternal life.
