

The elders are excited to announce a plan to return to worshipping together in one service. Lord willing, we will begin meeting on May 2 with a Sunday school hour from 9 – 10am and a single worship service from 10:30 – 11:45am.

To accomplish this, the worship service will transition from 25% non-distanced seating and 75% distanced seating that we currently use to a 50-50 split. A masked section will continue to be offered where it is today. This will provide enough seating for all who are currently attending our two services.

During the Sunday school hour, three adult Sunday school classes will be offered – two of which will be non-distanced (in Room 101A and Room 107) and one will be distanced (in the Worship Center). The high school and middle school Sunday school classes will also begin meeting under their Wednesday night protocols. Bethany Kids! will continue to provide classes through 5th grade during the Sunday school hour and through 2nd grade during the worship service under current protocols.

At this point, we still ask that masks be worn when moving around the building. As is the case now, masks may be removed while in conversation in the lobby or Worship Center as well as while seated.

We look forward to this next step as our church moves forward together.
